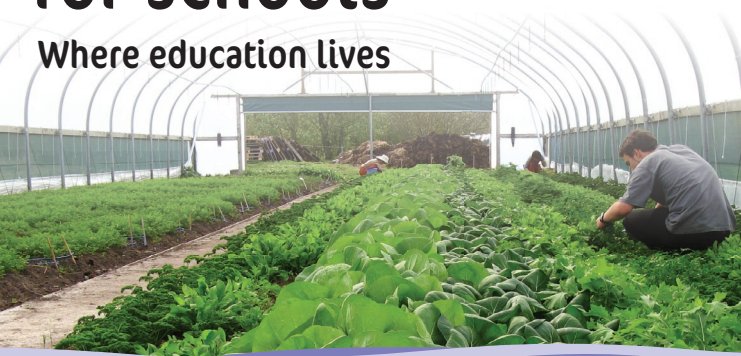


# Findhorn for schools
