NEW INTAKE PROGRAMME FOCALISER POSITIONS

The time allocation is still being finalised but will likely be 0.2 from September 2019 and 1.0 for the 6 week duration of the programme in Spring. Residential or non-residential.

Here is an exciting opportunity to help shape the future of the Findhorn Foundation learning journey. Could this be you?

The time has come to recruit two focalisers for the new six week intensive module of our intake programme which has been in development for the past year.

This programme is being designed as a prerequisite for our long term staff intake as well as a stand-alone guest programme for “world servers,” (*as Peter Caddy used to call it*). It will run for the first time from 22 February to

28 March 2020. Two focalisers will hold the programme full time for 6 weeks and participate in the detailed shaping of curriculum and schedule together with Gabi, Jackie and Jamie. Focalisers will contribute to choosing content and structure as well as deliver the programme.

This role requires grounded and embodied experience as a co-worker and a good understanding of the sacred nature of the journey towards becoming a member of staff in the Findhorn Foundation, as well as an awareness of differing needs and perspectives of participants.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- **HOLD** a full time four-week introduction and training programme
- **HOLD** a two-week deepening and integration programme
- **ASSESS** written applications and interview and hold attunements with applicants both before and post programme re next steps
- **CO-CREATE** the content and schedule of the programme
- **PARTICIPATE** in selecting and liaising with presenters
- **PROVIDE** individual and group support for participants
- **EMBODY** and **TRANSMIT** our spiritual values
- **SUPPORT** participants in their work in and with the transformational field
- **MAINTAIN** relationship and liaising with members of the Living Core Hub and related departments in other hubs.

REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to embody our spiritual values and inspire others to do the same
- Strong spiritual life and connection with energies supporting and guiding the FF
- Good communication skills, good people skills
- In-depth understanding and awareness of the FF as a transformational field
- Thorough understanding of our three core principles
- Group holding and educational skills
- In depth understanding of the needs of the Service departments of the Living Core as well as other aspects and areas of the FF
- Programme development skills
- Ability to closely cooperate and work in a co-focalisation role
